BAND BIOGRAPHY

El Juntacadáveres is based in Belgium and was founded in 2009 by Enrique 'Kike' Noviello, hailing from Argentina.

In 2011 the band won the Belgian 'Mano Mundo' Music Competition. In the summer of 2011 El Juntacadáveres was the opening act for the Gotan Project in Belgium. In 2012 they played several festivals in the Benelux (Sfinks Mundial, Airbag, Polé Polé) and in 2014 they are invited to perform at the prestigious Sziget-festival in Budapest.

MUSICIANS

Enrique 'Kike' Noviello (Argentina): sax, bandoneon, vocals, artistic director
Inspirator and bandleader Enrique Noviello, sax player/ composer/ arranger, is born in 1974 in Buenos Aires. He studied psychology, veterinary medicine, music theory (Conservatory of Buenos Aires) and saxophone (Conservatorio Nacional de Musica, Mar del Plata). Since his arrival in Belgium he has played and recorded with many bands.

Kris Strybos (Belgium): hiphop, electro, beatbox
Kris Strybos a.k.a Scale is one of the 'founding fathers' of the beatbox-scene in Belgium and performs as DJ Scale. He has broadened his horizon and is now also active as a writer, slam poet and more.

Alfredo Bravo (Chili): drums
Alfredo started drumming when he was 18 and already recorded when still living in Chili. In 2002 he moved to Belgium with his drums as his only luggage. He quickly became part of the Antwerp music scene and plays in several bands.

Onan Van de Weyer (Belgium): guitar
Onan studied at the Antwerp Conservatory in Belgium en specialised in tango music at the Rotterdam Conservatory. He is a versatile musician who also received a Dutch Pop Award. Not only is he performing with several bands, he is also a guitar teacher.

Michel Spiessens (Belgium): bass
Michel studied double bass and bass (guitar) and performs in numerous Belgian bands. He is also a music therapist and composes scores for films and documentaries.

Domingo de Jesus López Díaz (Mexico): piano
Domingo studied marimba, piano and percussion at the Universidad de Ciencias y Artes de Chiapas in Tuxtla Gutiérrez, Chiapas, Mexico. He was a teacher at several music institutes. Among the participants in his workshops marimba were Victor Patron, Duglas Bringas and Victor Mendoza.

Pato Lorente (Belgium): bandoneon
Pato Lorente met Alfredo Marcucci in the nineties. He studied with this great bandoneon player and later performed with him in the 'Veritango' orchestra. Pato also went to Buenos Aires for further studies with Julio Pane and Carlos Pazo. He is involved in several tango projects and teaches at a music academy in Brussels.
